Since the December meeting, it was reported that overload testing was more destructive to the formed Receiver than with the current process Receiver. Reviews of allers to improve strength are being made. Additional gunds are being requested to complete the investi-

gations of strength and appearance.

Marketing would prefer that the venture into the formed Receiver be in a new gan. There is the possibility of damage to the public acceptance of current models by changing from a machined Receiver. Marketing would consider adapting to a current model if the following three objectives can be met.

- 1. Strength
- Confidence in the braze
- 3. Appearance

R & D has reviewed the use of the formed Receiver design for the 28 and 410 gauge. The cost, principally for equipment and dies, can only be justified on a product having a reasonably high volume.
