

SHOTGUNS - contd.Fore End - contd.

The plant is to make a quality audit check to determine the percentage of cracks for comparison with present production. In addition, shipping tests of the present product and guns with the new Fore End are to be made.

Committee Action:

The tests outlined are to be made. The fiberglass reinforcement only strengthens the outward movement of the rear end of the Fore End. R & D is to continue development to further improve the strength.

1968 Shotgun Specifications

Marketing proposes to drop several gun specifications in 1968. The items proposed for discontinuance are listed in the attached Exhibit 1.

MODEL 879, 12 GA. AUTOLOADING SHOTGUN
(MODEL 600A ERI MONTGOMERY WARD & CO.)

Production reported that the schedules would be met.

Marketing requested changing the location of the proof stamp or the use of a different marking. The present REP identifies the gun as a Remington product.

MODEL 878, 12 GA. AUTOLOADING SHOTGUN FOR CANADA

The proposed furnishing of five hundred (500) Model 878 shotguns in six (6) Barrel specifications to Canada was discussed. There would be no conflict with the Montgomery Ward & Co. contract; however, if the guns are to be furnished Canada, Marketing will inform Montgomery Ward & Co.
