Model 700 BDL Grade

1. Shrouded Bolt Plug
2. Bolt Handle - minor change to configuration
3. New Stock checkering design and forearm shape
4. Safety Thumb Piece revision
5. Damascene finish on Bolt
6. Polish finish on Floor Plate and Trigger Guard
7. "F" and "S" marking
8. Elevation Screw adjustment for Rear Sight
9. Improved metal finish

Marketing stated there was insufficient sales potential to add a 308 caliber rifle to the custom line. The proposed rifle would be similar to the sniper rifle furnished the Marine Corps except with commercial finish.

Exhibit 1 lists the calibers Marketing is proposing to drop in 1968. The net result should not be significant as most customers will purchase another caliber rifle.
