

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 1100 AUTOLOADING SHOTGUNFore End

Production equipment to add the fiberglass reinforcement to the Fore End should be completed so that full production can start by the end of September.

The question was raised regarding the effect on the fiberglass insert of extensive shooting. While no tests have been made, the opinion is that with adequate bonding, there would be no problem.

Committee Action:

Fore Ends with fiberglass reinforcement are to be furnished Bridgeport for use on Model 1100 guns used for ammunition testing to determine effect of extended shooting.

SHOTGUN AND RIFLE SPECIFICATIONS FOR 1968

The proposed discontinuance of several specifications of shotguns and rifles for 1968 as listed in Exhibit II was reviewed. The acceptance of the proposal was recommended by Marketing and Production. The opinion was expressed that the added costs to produce the low volume items cannot be accurately determined. Also customers wanting a Remington product would select guns from those offered. The net effect that dropping the suggested items probably would not affect Remington total sales or profit.

Committee Action:

The Operations Committee approved dropping the gun specifications shown as Exhibit II for 1968.
