SUBJECT: SPECIFICATIONS - MODEL 1100 - 20 GAUGE - for 1969

Reference is made to my letter of October 2, 1967 relative to the above subject. The following is for further clarification.

MODEL 1100 - 20 GAUGE FIELD GUN WITH 2-3/4" CHAMBER BARREL

The present 20 Gauge lightweight, mahogany wood, field gun with standard weight receiver, will be discontinued as such.

The above 20 Gauge guns would be replaced by the guns with lightweight receivers and mahogany wood, selling for \$10.00 more than the walnut wood guns with standard weight receivers. This would make available to the hunter for field shooting the 20 Gauge Model 1100 shotgun with walnut wood and standard weight receiver (at same price as 12 and 16 Gauges) in the present eight different specifications, and the 20 Gauge Model 1100 shotgun with mahogany wood and lightweight receiver (at \$10.00 above walnut and standard weight receiver gun) in the same eight specifications.
