

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 870 SLIDE ACTION SHOTGUNSMarine Corps Version

Production reported that sample formed blanks of the upper and lower Bayonet Adapter have been received. The vendor was released to produce a pilot quantity which is promised Nov. 25. Delivery of tooling for the secondary operations has been delayed until January 1969. Sample guns probably can be assembled in January as scheduled.

Regarding the inquiry for twenty-four (24) guns and spare Barrels with the A & W Diverter, Military Sales expects to receive an order when the prototype is reviewed with the Marine Corps. Gun costs have been supplied and steps taken to reduce the delivery time when the order is received.
