R & D has ordered a Universal carbine rifle which is advertised as being Teflon plated. Review of the possible application of Teflon plating to any components in other current models has been held until Production plating facilities are available. Marketing indicated there may be applications for Teflon plated components in law enforcement and military version guns.

In a letter dated January 10, 1969, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1, a request was made for the F & F Department of Du Pont to furnish Marketing with information to evaluate the promotional material that should be used.

RIM FIRE RIFLES

POSITION TARGET RIFLE

R & D reported that in addition to continued adcuracy testing, the suggested program is to replace the Model 40XB with two versions of a Position Target Rifle. These are proposed to meet the Anschutz competition.

One which would be produced by the Pfant would be a prone rifle with adjustable Butt Blate. Production has been furnished drawings of the Stock and Fire Control changes for estimating. This rifle would be priced at approximately \$225.00.

The second would be a position rifle with complete International Match hardware. For the low volume hardware components, it is planned to process using R & D N/C machines. This rifle would list for approximately \$325.00.

Military Sales will have to determine if the present Model 40XB Stock should be retained for volume government orders.

Committee Action:

Economics are to be developed for the proposed target rifle program and submitted to the Operations Committee for review.
