

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 870, 28-410 GAUGEMODEL 1100, 20-28-410 GAUGE - contd.Committee Action:

The outlined program to match Gas Cylinder and Piston Seal dimensions and release Model 1100, 410 gauge 2½" chamber skeet guns for shipment was approved.

MODEL 870-1100 LEFT HAND SHOTGUNS

The estimated full factory costs for the proposed Model 870-1100, 12 and 20 gauge left hand shotguns (Exhibit 2) and the estimated project costs and economics (Exhibit 3) were reviewed. It is proposed to announce these shotguns in 1971.

Committee Action:

The Operations Committee approved and recommends General Management authorization to release to production. A project is to be prepared.

MODEL 870-1100 "ALL AMERICAN" TRAP GUNS

A prototype of the proposed "All American" trap gun was reviewed with Marketing. Several changes were recommended. Another model will be submitted to Marketing in July.

MODEL 1100 AUTOLOADING SHOTGUN

Production reported a summary of replacements for Model 1100 Receivers extending over a period of the past three years. The available data are not segregated for specific causes, such as brazing failures to the Magazine or Action Spring Tubes, Barrel Supports, broken lock studs and visual defects. No specific data are available on Barrel replacements because of cracked extensions. A review of the returns by production does not indicate abnormal conditions.
