

RIM FIRE RIFLES - contd.MODEL 541-S RIM FIRE CLIP
MAGAZINE SPORTER RIFLE

The Model 541-S is the basic Model 581 Clip Magazine action. A sporter version is proposed with the selling price to be in the \$100 range. R & D is preparing a prototype with maximum features and will estimate the added costs of each element. When reviewed with Marketing, each element can be evaluated in arriving at the features and selling price. This rifle is scheduled for a 1971 announcement.

TRAPS

R & D reported that the concept of an electric trap that would be comparable with the Winchester Tournament design is progressing. Some preliminary testing has been completed and appears promising. The schedule is to complete design October 1 and build a prototype by January 1, 1970.

TARGET TELESCOPES

R & D reported difficulty in obtaining mounts from the vendor for the Remington Telescope. Selling the Remington Telescope without a mount is being considered. The manufacture of a Remington mount will be evaluated.

At present, orders have been received for approximately two hundred and fifty (250) Remington Telescopes.

BENCH REST BULLETS

R & D reported that with the presses and tooling, pilot 222 caliber bullets have been produced. Testing indicates excellent accuracy as illustrated by a target shown to the Committee.

Production will not be possible until the press promised for shipment in August is in operation.

The meeting adjourned at 12:45 p.m. The next meeting is scheduled at Ilion, Thursday, July 17, 1969 at 11:00 a.m.
