

SHOTGUNS - contd.

MODEL 870, 28-410 GAUGE
MODEL 1100, 28-410 GAUGE

R & D reported that one of the Model 1100, 410 gauge guns which Federal had for testing failed to function. Upon return of the gun, it was found that the Magazine Tube was bent. This was corrected and the gun then functioned satisfactorily and was returned. An exchange of Barrels was also made to provide the present two orifice hole design. The contact has not been available for further review of Federal's testing.

November 4, 1969, Marketing issued a letter to the Regional Managers that additional quantities of Model 1100 and 870 Matched Pairs will be made available. One additional "non-cancellable" order would be accepted from each wholesaler. Quotas were established by district with a possible total additional ordering of two thousand (2000) Matched Pairs. Firm orders will be accepted until December 15, 1969. Shipments for the additional Matched Pairs is scheduled during the first six months of 1970. Unallocated sets will be available to fill approximately two hundred (200) special requests.
