MODEL 870-1100 LEFT HAND SHOTGUNS (Introduction 1971)

Production reported that tooling for the left hand Model 870-1100, 12-20 gauge shotguns is 95% complete. Pilot operations have started on the Model 870 Receiver.

Completion of Remington and conversion of standard machines is required before operations can start on the Barrel. The broaching machine should be completed so that pilot operations on the Breech Bolt can start in May.

All purchase blanks should be received in June. This program is on schedule.

Marketing stated that Winchester, the only other manufacturer that markets a left hand shotgun, offers the Model 1400 autoloader in the equivalent of ten (10) 12 gauge specifications. Six (6) of these are covered by the variable Winchester clokes.
