Springs and one (1) Extractor. R & D and Production have a program to improve the life of the parts on which breakages have been reported.

It is planned to continue the Bridgeport test. Results will again be reported at the May meeting.

Marketing was furnished one hundred and sixteen (116) chrome plated Pistons and Piston Seals. Samples were sent to the south and southwest areas for testing. A report will be made at the September meeting.

It was recommended that the cost to chrome plate the Piston and 83 Piston Seal in the R & D experimental laboratory be developed.

If the change is made to chrome plate the parts, it should be in all gauge Model 1100 shotguns.

MODEL 870 "ALL AMERICAN" TRAP GUN (Introduction 1972)

R & D reported that the N/C robot engraving machine construction should be completed so that tryout can start in August 1970.

Further development has been required to program the N/C robot checkering in the crip area of the Stock. It is believed the problem has been solved. It is planned to proceed with the construction of a N/C robot checkering machine and its fixturing.

Red Is preparing projects to provide funds to complete the production equipment and fixturing for the N/C robot metal engraving and wood checkering.

Marketing was requested to determine if a more suitable carrying case can be obtained for the proposed Model 870 "All American" Trap gun.
