2. The Barrel would be the magnum Barrel same as the Model 660 except 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " length and roll marked "Mohawk".
3. The Barrel and Receiver would have the same finish as the Model 788.
4. The Trigger is to be gold plated (Mohawk brand designation).
5. Receiver is to be marked Mohawk.

The indicated increase in volume shown in the Exhibit 4 estimated costs and project economics requires three additional standard machines and fixtures for Receiver machining line capacity. Also regrouping of the two (2) Tri-Ordinate machines will be required. The estimated expenditures of one hundred and five thousand dollars (\$105,000) are not included in the present production forecast. Expenditures would have to be made in 1970 to provide capacity for 1971.

Committee Action:

The Committee approved the Marketing recommendation to drop the Model 660 in 1971 and offer jobbers the Mohawk 600 Bolt Action rifle. General Management approval to release for production was recommended.
