The mold for the 10-shot Magazine Box is used for the Model 581 and Nylon 77 with different inserts. The mold is producing Model 581 parts. Tryout with the Nylon 77 inserts is scheduled the week of May 4.

Marketing was considering dropping the Model 550 autoloading rim fire rifle and changing to a Mohawk brand. Based on the current costs and low earnings, the recommendation was made to drop the Model 550 autoloading rim fire rifle in 1971.

In the discussion of the rim fire line, the suggestion was made to also drop the Model 514 Bolt Action single shot rim fire rifle in 1971.
