

RIM FIRE RIFLESMODEL 541S SPORTER BOLT ACTION
CLIP MAGAZINE RIM FIRE RIFLE
(Introduction 1972)

R & D reviewed the prototype Model 541S Sporter Bolt Action Clip Magazine Rim Fire Rifle. The specifications are shown as Exhibit 7.

The estimated costs and economics for the third year 1974 (Exhibit 8) were reviewed. The project construction costs cover eight (8) machines. Six (6) are required for the Stock, one (1) for the Trigger and one (1) polish jack. In addition, the metal engraving and the Stock checkering would use the N/C equipment provided under R & D Projects TI-116 and 117.

Committee Action:

Consideration of the proposed sporter rifle will be held until the Production survey of space requirements and the proposed location for the new equipment is resolved.
