

CENTER FIRE RIFLESMODEL 732 AUTOLOADING CENTER FIRE RIFLE
(Introduction 1974)

R & D showed a mock-up of the proposed Model 732 autoloading center fire rifle. Proposed features of the rifle were discussed. Further review of the specifications by R & D and Marketing is required.

MODEL 700 BOLT ACTION CENTER FIRE RIFLECaliber 25-06 "Varmint Special" BDL Grade
(Introduction 1971)

Production reported that Model 700, Caliber 25-06 "Varmint Special" 83 pilot rifles were assembled and tested. A percentage did not meet accuracy specifications. The decision was made to start another lot of Barrels for pilot assembly. Pilot assembly is now scheduled for December.

Caliber 17 Rem.
(Introduction 1971)

Production reported that Model 700, Caliber 17 Rem. Barrels are ready for the chambering operation. The last chamber cutter has been received. It is indicated that Barrels can be completed so that pilot rifles can be assembled the first part of December.

MOHAWK 600 BOLT ACTION CENTER
FIRE RIFLE TO REPLACE MODEL 660
(Introduction 1971)

Production reported that pilot operations on Mohawk 600 Stocks and Barrels are in process. Pilot rifles should be assembled in December 1970.
