

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 870 "ALL AMERICAN" 12 GAUGE TRAP GUN - contd.

Marketing reported that the major manufacturers of hardware for cases have been contacted to try to find a better lock at an acceptable cost for the Model 870 "AA" carrying case. Two samples have been selected for further review.

Committee Action:

The Operations Committee decided that the proposed program to complete the N/C engraving and checking equipment should start immediately. The Model 870 "All American" is to have priority over the Model 541-S.

The Chairman directed that he be notified immediately of any further delays in the Du Pont work on this program.

MODEL 870 AND 1100, 12 GAUGE 34" TRAP BARRELS

Trial and pilot production of Model 870 and 1100, 12 gauge 34" Trap Barrels will start the week of September 13. It is planned to complete the Model 870 Barrels in September and the Model 1100 Barrels in October.

The large bore Model 870 Barrels are being completed now and will be turned over to R & D to establish sight line.
