

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 870 "ALL AMERICAN" 12 GAUGE TRAP GUN - contd.

Marketing showed samples of the locks that have been selected for the case and they were favorably received. Final details of attaching the locks to the case are being worked out between Excelsior Hardware and Protecto Plastics. This should be resolved and a final quotation should be received from Protecto Plastics by October 29. The first production lot of cases could be delivered 10-12 weeks from receipt of order.

MODEL 870 AND 1100, 12 GAUGE 34" TRAP BARREL
(Introduction 1972)

Production reported that trial and pilot quantities of Model 870 and 1100, 12 gauge 34" Trap Barrels will be completed the week of October 25. These Barrels have been processed through the turn operation.

R & D reported that initial testing of Model 870 Barrels indicates that the point of impact is satisfactory.

THE 3200 SHOTGUN
(Introduction 1973)

Project AD-3200-4 has been approved by the Board of Directors.

R & D reported that there are several design changes being made as a result of the field testing. The major change will be to widen the Ejector so that it will cover more of the circumference of the chamber. Other changes will be:

- . Cam angle of Mono-Block and Top Lock.
- . Top Lock Rod diameter increase.
- . Raise Fore-end Latch.
- . Increase Firing Pin indent.
