

RIM FIRE RIFLES - contd.MOHAWK 10 C CLIP MAGAZINE RIM FIRE  
RIFLE TO REPLACE THE NYLON 77  
(Introduction 1972)

Marketing recommended that the replacement for the Nylon 77 be designated "Mohawk 10 C." "10" is for shots and "C" is for clip.

The revised economics were reviewed (Exhibit 2).

Committee Action:

The Operations Committee accepted "Mohawk 10 C" as the designation for the rifle to replace the Nylon 77. The revised economics were accepted.

Reporting on this item will be dropped.

ARMS SPECIFICATIONS

Marketing made the following report on arms specifications:

Shotguns

Model 1100, 12-20 gauge left hand shotguns will be introduced with Vent Rib specifications only. In 1972, all plain Barrel specifications will be dropped on Model 870 left hand shotguns.

At a future date to be established, 16 gauge Vent Rib specifications will be dropped in Model 870 and 1100 shotguns.

At a future date to be established, all 20 gauge regular specifications in Model 870-1100 shotguns will be dropped. This probably will be done when the 20 gauge lightweight gun cost is reduced by press forming these Stocks.

Center Fire Rifles

The Model 788, 30-30 caliber is to be out of production in 1971 but remain in the 1972 catalog. The Model 700, 350 Rem. Mag. and
