Production reported that the project for the Model 700 left hand rifle has been authorized. Tool design has started.

(Introduction 1972)

Production reported that trial and pilot Barrels and Receivers for the Model 541S Sporter rifle will be completed by Nov. 15. Stocks will be completed by Nov. 15. Assembly and testing will be completed by Dec. 1 using parts that are not engraved or checkered.

R & D showed samples of Fore-end Tips that were stained to obtain a color match. Production does not consider this to be a practical process.

ARMS SPECIFICATIONS

At the October meeting, Marketing reported that Model 1100, 12-20 gauge left hand shotguns will be introduced with Vent Rib specifications only (approved at the May 11, 1971 meeting.) In 1972, all plain Barrel specifications will be dropped on Model 870 left hand shotguns.

Committee action was not recorded in the October minutes and is recorded below.

Committee Action:

At the October, 1971 meeting, the Operations Committee accepted Marketing's recommendation to delete all plain Barrel specifications on Model 870 left hand shotguns in 1972.
