MODEL 700 BOLT ACTION CENTER FIRE RIFLE - LEFT HAND  
(Introduction 1973)

Production reported that tool design and procurement for the Model 700 left hand rifle is in progress. Equipment is being ordered.

MODEL 541S SPOTTER BOLT ACTION  
CLIP MAGAZINE RIM FIRE RIFLE  
(Introduction 1972)

Production reported that several Model 541S Spotter rifles have been assembled and are being tested. This rifle is to be offered without sights but available as an option. It is indicated that Remington sights are not adequate for elevation so it is planned to offer a commercial sight as the optional accessory.

Fore-end Tips have been produced with better color graining; however still not to the desired rosewood pattern. On initial production, it will be necessary to stain the tip. Production will work out this problem.

R & D reported that the first 100 components N/C checkered and engraved should be completed in February, 1972.
