Committee Action:

The Operations Committee accepted the revised gun specifications (Exhibit 1 - page 1), and the high grade specifications for 1973 (Exhibit 1 - page 2). The Committee directed that a project be prepared for the N/C engraving equipment required to produce the high grade gun.
