It was proposed to plate internal parts in the Frame Assembly. This should be tried to see if it is desirable.

4. N/C Engraving

In order to produce the high grade guns, it will be necessary to do the engraving on N/C equipment. The N/C engraving machine provided on the Model 870 "All American" shotgun does not have any excess capacity available. The 3200 Shotgun project does not provide N/C engraving equipment.

It is necessary to write a project for the N/C engraving equipment. One additional machine will provide capacity to produce something in addition to the high grades. It was thought that a Model 1100 "All American" Trap Gun could be produced - about 1,000 per year - and used as part of the justification for the engraving equipment. This gun would sell for \$600.00.

5. Marketing indicated that the Ilion plant would be used in advertising The 3200 Shotgun. Also it is likely that the Outdoor Writer's Seminar will be at Ilion in the fall of 1972.

It was agreed that this should be reviewed again before the January Operations Committee Meeting. Tentative dates of January 14 or 17 were set to meet at Kingston.
