Production discussed the manufacturing space requirements for this program. The Model 742-X and companion slide action rifle probably could be accommodated in existing space. The complete family of guns could not be accommodated and retain the existing major product line.

Marketing will begin to review forecasts. However, until more is known about the new guns, definite phase-out schedules for existing guns cannot be established. The possibility of retaining guns in the Mohawk line also exists.
