

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 870 "ALL AMERICAN" 12 GAUGE TRAP GUN - contd.

When the checkering equipment is in operation, it will produce at four times the rate of engraving components for this gun.

It is planned to leave the checkering machine in Wilmington for development of The 3200 Shotgun checkering. The Model 870 tooling will be moved to Ilion and used on the new machine for The 3200 Shotgun which should be delivered in July.

MODEL 870 AND 1100, 12 GAUGE 34" BARRELS
(Introduction 1972)

Production reported that tooling for the Model 1100 Duck-Goose Barrel will be completed by July 1. Production will start when the tooling is available.

THE 3200 SHOTGUN
(Introduction 1973)

R & D reported that the point of impact of The 3200 Shotgun was raised on the trap guns for field test. Test results show this gun now shoots equal to the Berazzi over and under. Model drawings must now be made for the Stock and Ventilated Rib. These will be completed by September 1. The point of impact will be set up for the 22 yard shooting position on the Trap field. The following specifications are for the revised trap gun:

Point of impact at 40 yards:

10" high Top Barrel
7" high Bottom Barrel

Stock dimensions are:

Drop at comb $1\frac{1}{4}$ "
Drop at heel $1\frac{3}{4}$ "

Pull: 14- $\frac{3}{8}$ "

Down pitch: $1\frac{1}{4}$ "
