NORMA AUTOLOADING SKEET TRAP

Marketing reported that R & D has been unable to complete its test and evaluation of this trap because of the three-phase motor. Attempts to locate a single-phase 110 volt, 60 cycle motor that will fit within the space provided for the present motor have been unsuccessful. There is considerable question as to the ability of a motor to endure the constant off-and-on switching required for the Norma trap operation and to provide a motor that delivers enough torque. Norma has been advised of our difficulty and they are attempting to locate a motor.

Use of this trap by Remington appears unlikely. This is a prototype trap. No production traps have been made.

PASELLI TRAP

Marketing reported that the Paselli manual trap that has been purchased for test and evaluation as a replacement for the Wonder Trap has not been received. A delivery date will be requested.
