Prototype guns are being made and it is planned to start shooting testing by January 1, 1973. Design is to be released by June, 1974. Marketing and endurance testing is required. No artist concept is available.

Marketing indicated that the single Barrel Trap gun is very popular. Statistics of use at the 1973 Grand American are to be reviewed. Also the recoil reduction is a good feature.

STEEL SHOT PROGRAM

Production had heard the steel shot program was being shelved for one year. No one could confirm; Marketing is to check.

ADHESIVE -FASTENED VENT RIB AND PHOTO-ETCHED MATTING

Completion of production aids and procedures, needed for initial production operation, is about 75% complete. Trial production operation will begin November 26 with M/1100, 12 Ga. Barrels (28", 30").

Photo-etched Matting is not dependent upon adhesive-fastening the Vent Rib. This was pushed ahead of the adhesive-fastening because matting capacity is needed.

Work on adhesive-fastening the Vent Rib is to resume. Previous tests have not produced a satisfactory bond and additional development in this area is required. A project is circulating for continuation of this job.

If additional capacity for Vent Rib fastening were required today, welding equipment would be purchased.
