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SHOTGUNS - contd.

MODEL 3200 FIELD MAGNUM SHOTGUN - contd.

Design improvements are needed to reduce or eliminate broken Top Tangs and stress marked Bottom Tangs before introduction of a magnum gun. Status of this work was reported earlier. No magnum guns are to be produced without the improvements.

R & D expects to achieve a life of 10,000 rounds of 3" magnum loads fired through the top Barrel. Firing the bottom Barrel stresses an over and under gun significantly less than firing the top Barrel with the result being increased gun life. It was suggested that this information be publicized.

MODEL 3200 TRAP 32" BARREL SHOTGUN (Introduction 1975)

Production reported that tool design has been completed and procurement is in progress for the Model 3200 32" sarrel shotgun. Trial and pilot has started.

R & D has no plans for a 32" Barrel gun for steel shot. 26

Production Barrel Assemblies are needed as soon as possible to test for point of impact. Some design revisions may be required to adjust the sight line

MODEL 3200 STNGLE BARREL TRAP SHOTGUN (Introduction 1976)

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R & D presented the Model 3200 single Barrel trap shotgun as part of a competition trap set - a complete package for shooting 16 gard singles; 17-27 yard handicap and doubles. The package Includes the single Barrel gun and interchangeable double Barrels Atted into a luggage type case. A prototype package was shown.

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
