

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 3200 FIELD MAGNUM SHOTGUN
(Introduction 1975)

R & D reported that work is concentrated on the point of impact problem with 3 inch magnum shells. It appears that the Vent Rib and center Barrel Spacer will have to be altered.

Marketing did show this gun at the field sales meeting and expects it to find reasonable customer acceptance.

MODEL 3200, 32" BARREL TRAP SHOTGUN
(Introduction 1975)

R & D reported that drawings for the 32" Barrels with revised sight line have been transmitted to Production.

Marketing noted the previous commitment for product availability in April, 1975. The possibility of offering this as an interchangeable Barrel Assembly is being discussed with R & D and Production.

MODEL 3200 COMPETITION SKEET AND TRAP SHOTGUN
(Introduction January, 1976 - revised from July, 1975)

Marketing reviewed this proposed addition to the Model 3200 product line. It was conceived in July, 1974 as a means to increase earnings of the line. Subsequent developments have indicated the introduction date should be delayed and product specifications upgraded if possible. It was recommended that introduction be changed to January, 1976.

1975 financial forecasts were made including the Competition Skeet and Trap guns. These forecasts now require revisions.
