MODEL 1100 - MODEL 870 - NEW GENERATION FOR ANNOUNCEMENT IN 1978 & 1979

INTRODUCTION

The new generation program for the M/1100 and M/870 will feature changes in <u>styling</u> and <u>engineering</u> which result in significant improvement of these models. We propose that the new generation M/1100 be announced in 1978, and followed one year later, in 1979, by the new generation M/870.

FIRST CHART

This first chart shows the styling changes for the New Generation M/#100

- The Model 1100 Field Grade will have redesigned pressed checkering patterns for both stock and fore end.
- The fore end will be restyled to enhance the gun appearance
- 3. New roll markings on the receiver panels will further accent the New Generation M21100 appearance.
- 4. A machined madazine cap will be therefuce cost and prevent the coloring and elegant problems of the present powder metal cap.
 - Stock dimensions will remain the same, with styling changes for the grap cap, butt plate and spacers.

The Skeet and Trap versions of M/1100 will be quite different from the Field grade. They will feature:

- 1. Cut checkering on the stock and fore end.
- Receiver markings will be engraved by the photo-etch process, for a higher quality appearance than field grade guns.
