

BENCH REST BULLETS

R & D reported that 226,000 bullets were produced in January. Scrap is being reduced and quality maintained.

Production reported that Ilion's cost analysis of the bullet job is completed and Lonoke's is in the mail. Analysis of these reports will help determine the future of this product.

TRAPSNEW MECHANICAL TRAP

(Introduction October, 1975 - revised from June, 1975)

R & D reported that it is proposed to expand the line of mechanical traps, revise design for reduced cost and introduce the first two versions at the October Sporting Goods Show. A proposed name offered was the "Flight Master Series."

1. Field Master: (Name not acceptable since it is the name of the Model 572 rim fire rifle.)

Excellent clay target trap with manual cocking by actuating the throwing arm and manual firing by pulling trigger handle. The trap will throw singles or doubles in a fixed flight path. Precision mechanism with oilite bronze bearings in all critical pivots, anti-backlash clutch, adjustable spring tension, precision throwing arm.

This trap would replace the Blue Rock trap.

2. Target Master:

All of the above features plus cocking handle for easy cocking and solenoid or manual trigger mechanism. This excellent trap can be placed in a skeet house with excellent results and fired remotely by using the solenoid.

This trap would replace the Wonder Trap.
