

CALIBER .270 CARTRIDGES WITH 130 GRAIN
POINTED SOFT POINT "CORE-LOKT" BULLETS

The Committee received the Marketing Department report submitted by G. T. Porter concerning five complaints from his area, which indicated a condition of greater than normal chamber pressure. Production presented the results of their investigation which included the possibility of powder contamination during the loading of this run of cartridges. The loading occurred July 28, 29, 30, 31, August 2, 3, and 4, 1971, and consisted of Lots LU28W, LU29W, LU30W, LU31W, LU02ID, LU03ID, and LU04ID.


The Committee agreed that the possibility existed that if a cartridge with contaminated powder were used in firearms in other than good condition and originally chambered and designed for this cartridge, a dangerous condition might exist.

COMMITTEE ACTION

The Committee directed that the Marketing Department initiate an immediate recall action of those lots of Caliber .270 ammunition manufactured July 28-August 4, 1971.

The next meeting will be at the call of the Chairman.
