
The Product Safety Committee met Friday, November 12, 1971, to review and approve the Dealer Letter concerning recall of Loneke .270 caliber 130 grain ammunition suspected of high pressure.

The Product Safety Committee met Monday, November 15, 1971, to discuss progress of the 270 caliber ammunition recall. It was reported that good progress is being made and cooperation of the distributors, dealers and Remington field force is excellent.

The following tests were conducted in various rifles with hand-loaded high pressure cartridges:

- #1 - Model 721 and Model 760 rifles with full charge of 4198 powder
- #2 - Model 760 with various mixtures of 4198 and 4350 powders
- #3 - Competitive rifles with full charge of 4198 powder

Details of these tests are attached.
