7mm EXPRESS REMINGTON

Production reported that the 7mm Express Remington ammunition returned with the Remington Model 700 rifle lockup complaint was loaded on the last shift of a load run from August 2 through August 9, 1979. Manufacturing test records indicate that we can isolate the period of contaminated powder in the 7mm Express Remington ammunition to the load run during the period specified above, which included 261,000 loaded rounds. We are attempting to obtain product samples from lots other than M09I, to see if we can further narrow the production lot or lots involved.
