Be sure to have your  
firearms checked regularly  
by a competent  
gunsmith or factory  
warranty station.

Firearms are mechanical devices and, as with any other mechanical device, they are subject to wear and should receive regular inspection and repair by a competent gunsmith or a factory warranty station.

All too often shooters wait until they experience an actual malfunction before turning their firearm over to a gunsmith. A program of preventive maintenance will discover potential problem areas that could lead to possible injury as well as loss of use of the firearm.

Then there's another reason. All too often shooters wait until just before the season begins to have their guns brought up to peak efficiency. Every year, gunsmiths, warranty stations and factories are inundated with repair work just before the seasons start. The result? Almost everyone has to wait.

Have your guns checked periodically, and try to do it in the off-season.
