of the 267,000 rounds recalled for case separations caused by an excessively deep cannelure, 96,874 rounds or 36.3% have been returned. The bulk of the recall probably has been returned since only 532 rounds have been returned since the last meeting. Product Service considers this a good return considering this was a relatively new cartridge. The pipelines were not full and it would be assumed that the cartridge would be used.
