- Recall statement to be drafted and released to the National Law Enforcement Telecommunications Network for publication to law enforcement agencies throughout the country.
- Product Service will write a computer program for data analysis and recall status.

(Secretary's Note: Subsequent to this Meeting, the Executive Vice President approved the Subcommittee's recommendations.)

MODELS 1100-870

Product Service reported that every one of the Model 1100 and Model 870 shotgun barrels produced during a one-week run in June, 1985, and sought for return because of possible susceptibility to longitudinal splits during extensive firing, have been returned to the Ilion plant. Due to 100% retrieval, the recall effort has been concluded.
