After a recent telephone conversation, I am sending you my Remington rifle Ser. # B-6340093.

Briefly, the problem is one of discharge. On two occasions, as I lifted the bolt to empty the rifle, the gun discharged (the bolt no longer slides or rotates as it originally did).

My first instance of unintentional discharge was during deer hunting of 1937 while among a group of fellow hunters. I lifted the bolt to empty the rifle and the gun discharged ; my finger tip was severely cut. That wasn't as bad as my embarrassment and shock about the incident.

I returned the gun from where it was purchased for inspection and necessary repair, It was cleaned and adjusted.

Recently, while sighting the gun, it happened again. I am extremely fortunate that no one else was around.


At this time, my confidence is all but diminished.
