On December 22, 1981, I purchased a used Remington Mohawk
600—Cal. 308—ser. #A6390843.

October 26, 1986—upon returning from hunting I set the
gun on the floor boards of my truck. At that time I took the
safety off to unload the gun and it discharged. The bullet
went through the firewall and into the intake manifold, cutting
several wires. The damage will run the hundreds of dollars.

I do not know if this has happened before with this model
rifle, but I thought I should notify you. Please advise me on
how to prevent this from recurring.

Fortunately no one was injured, and we were able to jury
rig the truck in order to drive it home.
