GENTLEMEN:

I am returning this gun for the second time to be repaired properly. This time I almost had a casualty when my friend and I were sitting our guns in. I'm afraid to use it.

The problem is the same as in February of 1975 when I returned it to you for repair. I've talked to a couple of gun dealers and they recommended I return it to you people for repair. They did not seem to want to fix it.

I just bought a Remington 270 and if this gun cannot be fixed, please let me know so I can or you can destroy it before someone seriously gets injured.

The problem with the gun is as follows: When you load it and close the bolt, the shell automatically goes off. The gun itself has no more than three boxes of shells through it and I bought it new. The reason for so few boxes of shells is I'm afraid to use it for fear of someone getting hurt. All my shells are Remington shells.

Could you please see what you can do or kindly let me know what I should do. Thanking you in advance.
