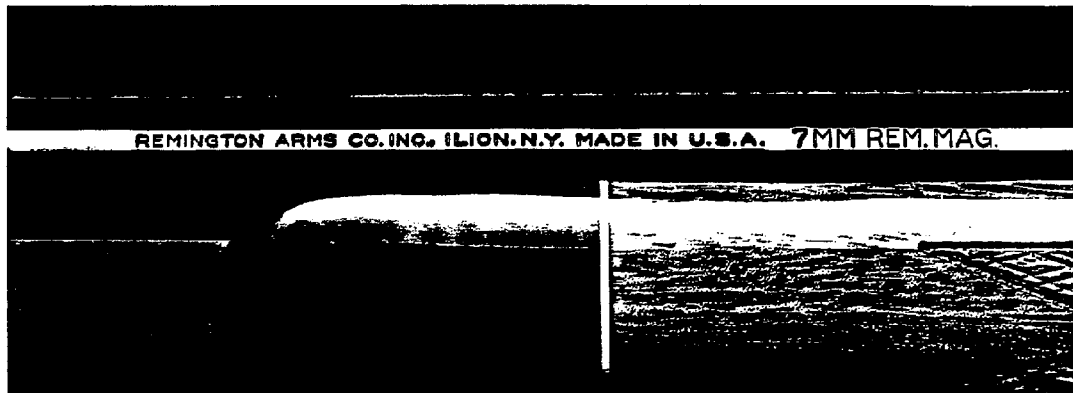
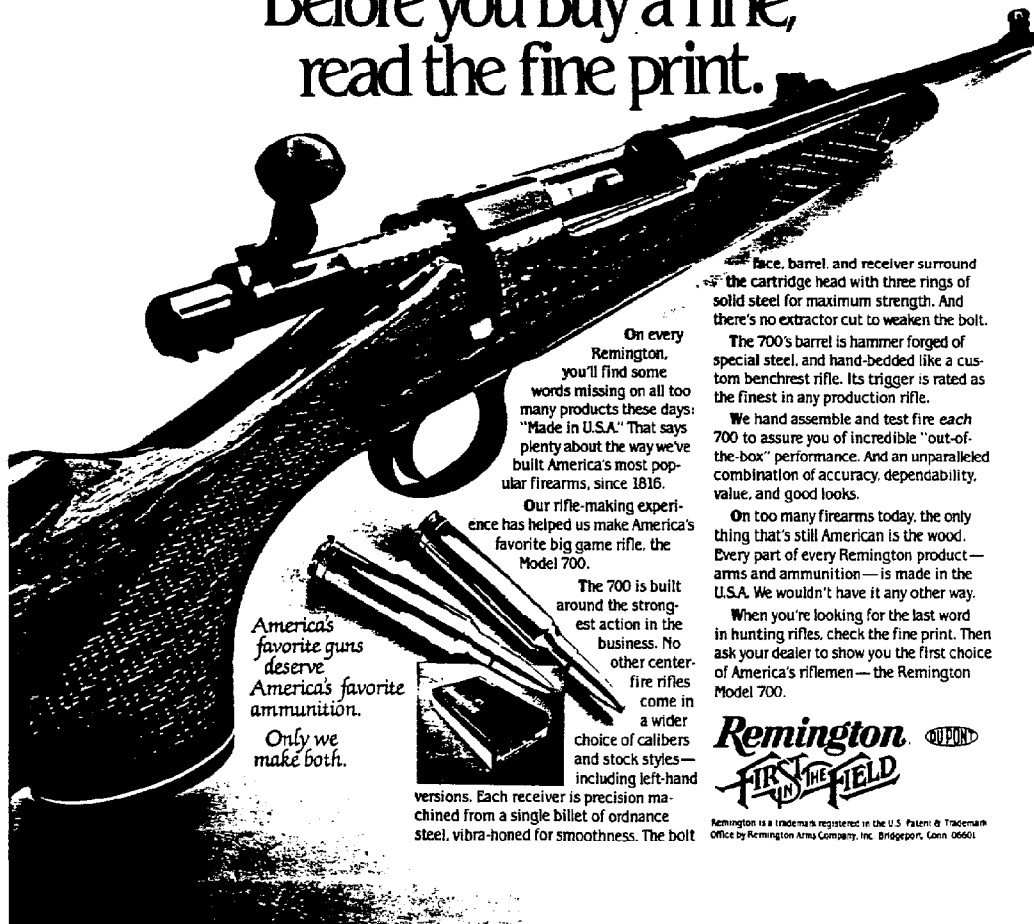

The 700's barrel is hammer forged of special steel, and hand-bedded like a custom benchrest rifle. Its trigger is rated as the finest in any production rifle.

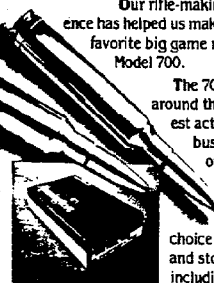
