First I would like to thank you for making such a fantastic product. It is such a breath of fresh air to find a product in today's age that is not only the best in its class but also cost effective. I can't tell you that I don't own other brands of guns, but I can tell you that when it comes to picking my favorites I always reach for my Remingtons.

All that being said, last hunting season (on my last hunt of the year) I decided to take my wife out on her first deer hunt. We spotted a group of deer and we moved into position for a shot. As she took aim I was coaching her on what to do. She squeezed the trigger and the gun fired, but she missed the deer. She told me later that the gun had not fired right when she pulled the trigger and that is why she missed the deer. I told her that she had probably not pulled the trigger hard enough and we would try again the next day. The next day we were in the same spot. Right before dark a deer stepped out into the opening about 75 yards away. Jamie took aim and as I watched her flip the safety off and pull the trigger nothing happened. I grabbed the gun, took aim at the deer and pulled the trigger. Still nothing. I grabbed the bolt and ejected the shell thinking it had misfired. As I slid a new shell into the chamber and dropped the bolt, the gun fired into the ground at my feet without me pulling the trigger.

This gun has been my primary hunting gun for the past 10 season. I am very meticulous with all my guns; this gun especially, since I use it the most. I hope you can do something with it. I am not sure what's wrong with it, but the weather was very cold when this happened (if that has anything to do with it). This is the first time I have ever had a problem with any Remington. I know you will help restore my confidence in this gun.
