TRIGGER PULL

Trigger pull is considered satisfactory.

SIGHTS

Front Sight

Front sight blade should be changed to conform to the shape of the Model when it is convenient for Ilion to do so without causing delay in delivery to warehouse.

Rear Sight

The approved rear sight is a flat top open sight as it appears on the model. There are, however, approximately 2200 semi-Buckhorn sights, similar to those on the Production Sample gun, available. It will cost about \$990.00 to scrap these sights. It is recommended, therefore, that these Semi-Buckhorn sights be used and that a change be made to the flat top sight when new sights are necessary.

TRIGGER PLATE AND
MAGAZINE BOTTOM
PLATE

We wish to remind Arms Products Committee members that Model 720 as shown in the Production Sample includes a trigger plate and a magazine bottom plate made of aluminum die-casting. These were not shown on the approved model since no dies were then available to produce them.
