11. Concerning shotgun frames -

Whereas the rifle respondents expressed a preference for take-down rifle frames by the narrow margin of 1.2 to 1, the shotgun respondents prefer the take-down type of frame on shotguns by the wide margin, of 9 to 1, as follows:

Solid frame	9.32

12. Checkering -

- on shotguns apparently is somewhat more desired than checkering on rifles, and worth more to the sportsman.

The findings (with corresponding data for rifles shown for ease of comparison):

As with rifles, preferences as to checkering vary with shooters' ratings, by age groups, and by the estimated retail price of the shotgun, as shown below:
