SUBJECT: PROJECT FTL-5 - PILOT LINE MACHINERY

For your information the writer along with Messrs. Hackman, DeRus and J. Brand of the R. & M. Group reviewed with H. R. Dorr and J. Strong the problem of installing M/721 production machinery in Building 48-1 and 48-1. Although there appears to be differences as to interpretation of provisions in the above project as it relates to installation of machinery both in the Technical Area and in the production areas, it is believed that we are essentially in agreement with H. R. Dorr as to disposition of the problem. We have now reached the point where work must be accomplished in the way of providing services and the installation of a number of production machines in order to avoid delay in scheduling.

In view of the above, it was agreed by the writer that we would proceed to issue work orders against this project to cover the installation utilities which are required as well as work orders to cover the work incidental to installation of each machine. However, the Project Engineer will arrange to secure estimates as to the cost for this entire job with the idea that it can be reviewed by all concerned and may possibly be used to clarify this phase of Project FTL-5 in a Part III such as is being advocated by the R. & M. Group.
