This rifle is completely new - the greatest improvement ever made in basic bolt action design - a creation of the finest engineering skill - a product of advanced manufacturing techniques and a triumph of modern gunsmithing.

This rifle speaks for itself. Its quality and value are self-evident. Its appearance, strength, accuracy, dependability, safety, balance, handling qualities and smoothness of operation are outstanding.

The light weight will make a strong appeal. The Model 721 weighs approximately 7-1/4 pounds, and the Model 722 approximately 7 pounds.

As evidence of careful designing by master craftsmen, two sizes of action are provided - each designed especially to accommodate the different lengths of cartridges -

SPECIFICATIONS

No. 721A "Standard" Grade - chambered for .30-06 Spfld. or .270 Win. cartridge with 24" barrel; or for .300 Mag. cartridge with 26" barrel. Carefully bored and rifled for extreme accuracy. New style sporting stock of genuine American walnut. Properly shaped pistol grip. Long, full, well rounded fore-end of semi-beavertail type. Shotgun style metal butt plate, checkered to prevent slipping. Rifle cocks on opening movement of bolt. Sensational new adjustable trigger without back lash - lightning fast let-off. Side-placed thumb operated safety. Polished bolt and action. Special bolt stop. Magazine holds 4 cartridges which with one in chamber gives a capacity of 5 shots, except .300 Mag. caliber which holds 3 in the magazine plus one in the chamber. White metal bead front sight mounted on matted ramp. Step adjustable sporting rear sight. Receiver drilled and tapped for adaptable scope mounts and standard micrometer receiver sights. Weight about 7-1/4 pounds. Length over-all 44-1/4", except .300 Mag. caliber - 46-1/4".

No. 722A "Standard" Grade - same as No. 721A except with shorter action and chambered for .300 Sav. or .257 Roberts cartridge, 24" barrel. Weight about 7 pounds. Length over-all 43-1/4".

The terms and conditons outlined in our letter of January 21, 1948 will also apply. On or before December 31, 1948 we will allow you a discount of 5% from the net prices on all Remington firearms purchased by you, direct from us, between January 21, 1948 and October 31, 1948 inclusive. Thereafter payment of this 5% discount will be made on a fiscal year basis for the period ending October 31 of each year.

The Models 721 and 722 will be packed 5 in a case. Weight per case, about 50 pounds.


Deliveries will be started as follows:
