Several months ago the Patent Attorney advised of the issuance of a new patent number (2,514,981) which had been assigned to cover the Fire Control Mechanism for the above rifles. It was suggested that this number be incorporated into our barrel markings as soon as convenient to make the change, also, that since one application was still pending, we continue to retain the phrase "Others Pending". However, from a sales standpoint it is advantageous for the number to be added without delay.

After checking this further, we find that this will involve the replacement of one dozen rolls (2 on hand for each caliber) which have an approximate value of \$750. In view of the obsolescence value which is involved, it is suggested that G. E. Pinckney advise W. L. Clay if, in his opinion, it is warranted to scrap the present rolls and the matter be referred to the Operations Committee for approval. Otherwise, instructions will be issued to the plant to revise their marking rolls without obsolescence which may be several years.
