We refer to our letter of May 3rd and your reply of May 25th regarding correspondence and sketches in connection with our Model 4OX received from Capt. Benjamin Naiman and our distributors, Zinuik & Co. Ltd., Haifa, Israel.

We are in receipt of further correspondence from Capt. Naiman as per his letter of August 22nd and mentioned sketches attached. We would appreciate your comments in connection with this letter and let us have your suggested reply.

Our distributors maintain that they have been unable to sell our Model 4OX Rifle to the Israeli small bore shooting members while they have been able to sell approximately 30 "Finnish Lion" target rifles since the first of the year.

Our distributors further advise that the drawings previously submitted and those attached are not exclusively Capt. Naiman's but are the result of a collective body of small bore shooters.

Your assistance in this connection will be appreciated.
