TEST PROCEDURE:

1. Two XP 100 pistols were borrowed from the Assembly area. These pistols were ready for packing.
2. Preliminary checks were made of these two pistols.
3. Both pistols were fired in the Test Lab area measuring if stock warpage did occur.
4. Warpage of stock was reviewed and this effect on P.O.I. was scheduled for checking.
5. The two XP 100 pistols were tested in the Research Range at a 50-yard range.
6. Accuracy data was measured and the point of impact shift was recorded.
7. Letter written describing results.
