MODEL 700 AND 660 CENTER FIRE RIFLES

Confirming the discussion with F. E. Morgan, Marketing believes that the volume for the Model 700 and 660 Center Fire Rifles can be increased to 110,000 per year. This would be either by redesign of the Model 660 or making this model a Mohawk brand.

The estimate for the Model 660 or Mohawk brand would be 20,000 per year. At present, the volume for which machines are to be provided for these lines is 100,000. This would be an increase of 10,000 rifles per year.

It is expected that this will be discussed at the April 23 Operations Committee Meeting. Machine requirements should be available so that Production can advise the Committee.
